	Promoting Physical Activity and Wellbeing Award - A school that has demonstrated a commitment to the health of all young people by embracing creative initiatives to raise awareness and enhance the impact of physical activity and emotional wellbeing. The Award will recognise schools who help children engage in more active and healthy lives in the school environment and beyond.		
	Give Back Award – (Any member of school staff) - The impact that volunteers can make on supporting a school's physical activity programme cannot be underestimated. The individual or group is a true inspiration in both what they do and how they do it by giving extra and going above and beyond the call of duty. By showing a positive outlook and dedication, they are admired and valued by children and school staff alike in providing meaningful support to the school without expected reward.		
	ACE Award – demonstrating Attitude, Commitment and Effort. Recognition of a young person who always shows a positive attitude, high levels of motivation and gives the best of their ability. As a good role model, they are supportive of peers and show respect and responsibility at all times.		
	<b>Extra Mile Award</b> - Awarded to a school that provides additional physical activity opportunities away from the PE curriculum and competition calendar. By providing a varied and vibrant offer through a whole school offer, children are encouraged to try new activities which encourage them to become more physically active at breakfast, lunchtime and/or afterschool clubs.		
	Participation in Virtual Sports Events — Nominations are sought from schools for an individual, class or year group who have shown great enthusiasm for the virtual sports events. This person or group of people have shown commitment and determination to complete the events showing at least one of the Spirit of the Games values of passion, determination, self-belief, respect, honesty and teamwork. Whether this is from home or in school either as a participant or as a leader.		
	The Special Recognition Award – Nominations are sought from schools to nominate someone who has shown a long standing contribution to school sport and / or for working above and beyond their role within school sport.
