PE and Sport Premium funding

We are delighted to share with you that the Department for Education (DfE) has confirmed that the Primary PE and Sport premium funding will continue at £320 million for the 2022-2023 academic year. The funding is a ring-fenced grant for English primary schools to provide additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE, sport and physical activity delivered in schools.

£320 million will be delivered to schools in 2022/23 to give more children access to high quality PE lessons and sporting opportunities, supporting both their physical and mental wellbeing.
